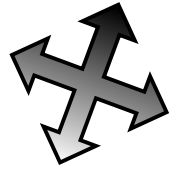


June Turning Points

1 Samuel 16:1

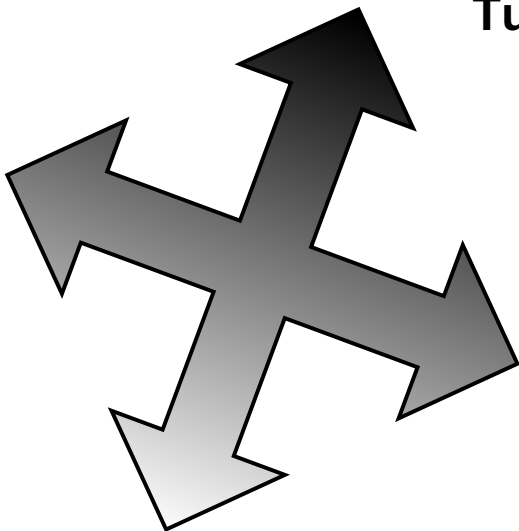

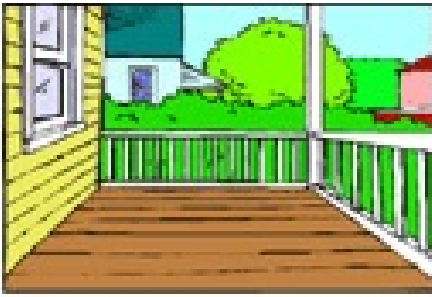

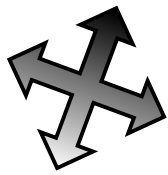
Let us always cling to the one that offers us hope!
